SINGAPOREAN ELECTED TO TOASTMASTERS INTERNATIONAL BOARD

He was elected to the two-year volunteer term at the organization's International Convention – held recently in Calgary, Alberta, Canada.

Kim Siong, an insurance adviser for AXA Insurance Singapore Private Ltd., has held a number of distinguished leadership positions within Toastmasters – including District Governor (overseeing a district that served about 200 Toastmasters clubs in Hong Kong, Macau, Singapore and Thailand). He's also helped to start eight new Toastmasters clubs.

The father of two has served as a contest judge for Toastmasters' World Championship of Public Speaking, and he has won many honors for his work in Toastmasters over the years, including being named District 51 "Outstanding Toastmaster of the Year" in 2003.
