## **WESTLAKE RESIDENT ELECTED TO TOASTMASTERS INTERNATIONAL BOARD**

DiCarlo, who works in corporate human resources for Eaton Corporation in Cleveland, has held a number of distinguished leadership positions within Toastmasters – including District Governor. She says being a Toastmasters member has opened up a whole new world of experiences for her.
