DISTRICT OFFICER POSITION TITLES AND VOTING PRIVILEGES IN DISTRICT COUNCILS

It is the policy of Toastmasters International that the voting strength of club representatives on district councils must be protected and preserved. To implement this policy, no district may add voting members to district councils who are not club representatives or members of the district executive committee.

No district shall change, modify, or add to district officer position titles nor change the function of these positions as described in the District Administrative Bylaws. The title "lt. governor" may be used only for the lt. governor education and training and for the lt. governor marketing.
